**RE:** **2016 Christmas Musicale Invitation Design**

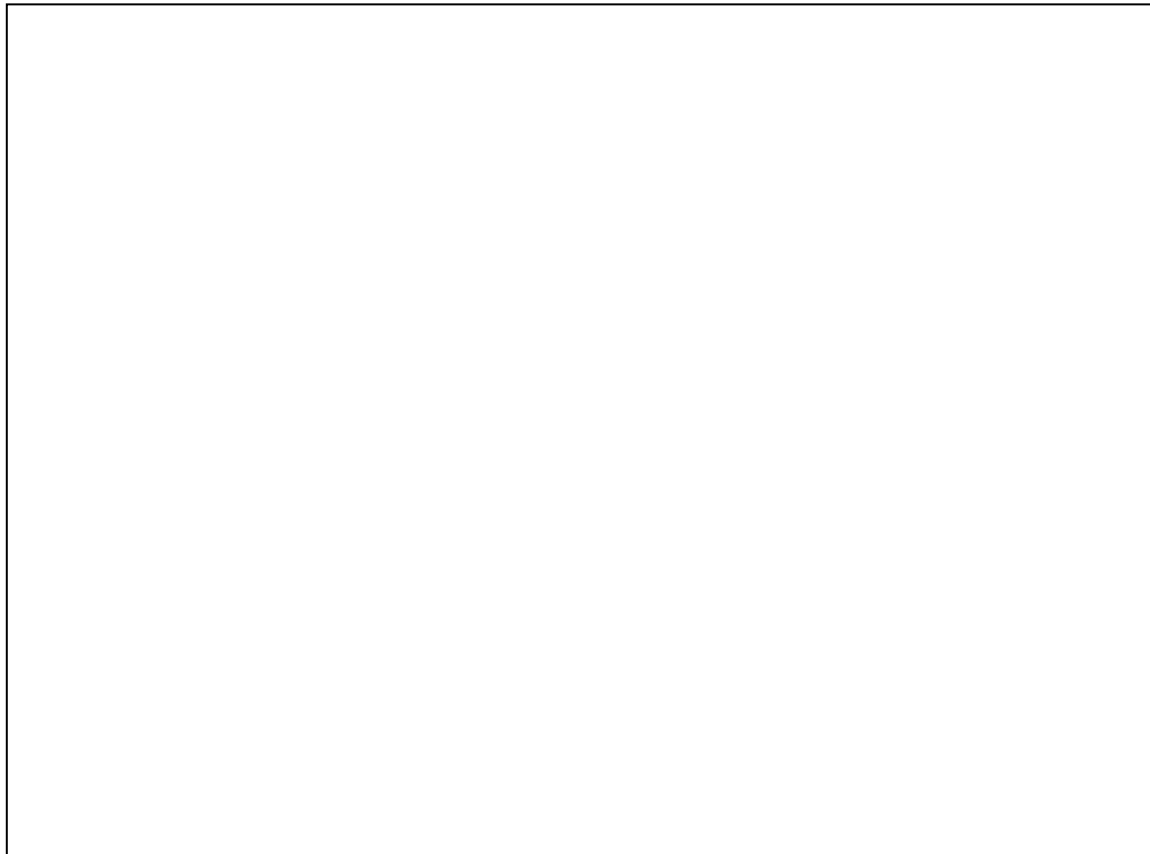
